General Information and Scope

European Congress on Molecular Spectroscopy (EUCMOS), an important biannual meeting of spectroscopists not only from the European countries, will be held for the twenty seventh time in September 2004 in Kraków, Poland. The congress is devoted to different branches of molecular spectroscopy and their wide applications in chemistry, physics, biochemistry, biology, medicine and technology (materials science). It covers all aspects of molecular spectroscopic techniques together with theoretical and computational methods of investigation of the structure and dynamics of molecular systems.

The congress is organized by and will be held at AGH-University of Science and Technology in Kraków, one of the largest technical universities in Poland.

The Organizing Committee of the XXVII EUCMOS cordially invites all spectroscopists to take part in the Congress and looks forward to seeing you in Kraków in September. We are sure that this meeting will be an exciting forum for all the participants to exchange their experience, present the latest results and to strengthen or start co-operation with colleagues from other countries.

Conference Program

Three types of sessions will be held at XXVII EUCMOS: plenary, topic and poster sessions.

Plenary sessions will include only a 45 minute keynote speech and a 30 minute invited plenary lecture. The topics of the keynote lectures will be appropriate to the conference topics selected by Scientific Program Committee, whereas the invited lectures proposed by the International Committee may not be strictly connected with the topic session.

Topic sessions will contain 15 minute oral presentations and will take place parallel. Each session will be led by two co-chairmen: local and international. All topic session chairmen are the members of the Scientific Program Committee of EUCMOS 2004.

The XXVII EUCMOS topic sessions are listed below:

Session 1: Vibrational spectroscopy, molecular structure and dynamics.

Session 2: NMR spectroscopy and molecular structure.

Session 3: Laser spectroscopy.

Session 4: Spectroscopy in materials science.

Session 5: Biospectroscopy.

Session 6: Spectroscopy of hydrogen-bonded systems.

Session 7: Spectroscopy in chemical analysis.

Session 8: Experimental methods and sampling techniques in spectroscopy.

Session 9: Theoretical and computational methods in spectroscopy.

Special session: Young spectroscopists' session.

For oral contributions the conference halls will be equipped with the overhead as well as a projector for Powerpoint presentations. If you need anything else for your presentation please contact the organizers. Please, remember that all writing and figures on overheads should be at least 8 mm high. It is better to use more transparencies with less and larger material on each.

Poster sessions will be arranged in the order corresponding to the topic sessions. The poster boards will be 0.90m (width) \times 1.60m (height). Adhesive tape will be provided by the organizers. Please make all writing and figures large enough that they can be read easily at a distance of at least 1 meter.

Conference Language

The official language of the conference is English. Therefore all the contributions should be submitted and presented in English. No simultaneous translation will be provided.

Abstract Submission

A one-page abstract of all contributed presentations should be submitted to the congress Organizing Committee. The abstract should be prepared using the Times New Roman 12 pt font and fit into a 160×240 mm portrait-oriented rectangular space. Such size leaves sufficient margins on a A-4 format page. The main text of the abstract should be single spaced but the title, names and affiliations should be prepared using 1.5 setting. The name of the presenting author should be underlined. Please, use the following style of heading.

The authors are kindly asked to indicate the session for their presentation below the abstract.

There are two possible ways to submit an abstract to the XXVII EUCMOS:

- **Electronic transfer by e-mail:** an abstract should be sent by e-mail as an attached file to the message (e-mail address: eucmos2004@agh.edu.pl). Only MS Word for Windows files of the required layout will be accepted. The reception of the abstract will be notified by e-mail.
- Using regular mail: two camera-ready printed copies of the abstract together with the disk containing the text written in MS Word for Windows editor should be mailed to the XXVII EUCMOS Organizing Committee. Only the abstracts of the required layout can be accepted. The reception of the abstract will be notified provided an e-mail address of the corresponding author is given.

Conference Proceedings

The invited lectures and a selection of the contributed papers will be published as a special issue of the Journal of Molecular Structure. There are no specific length restrictions for manuscripts, although papers should be of a length appropriate to the material presented at the Conference. Only papers containing significant new research results and/or critical review material will be considered for publication. Where an individual or research group has several related contributions, they are strongly encouraged to submit a single manuscript featuring the most original aspects of the work; multiple short papers from an individual or research group will *not* be accepted.

Authors wishing to submit a paper should bring their manuscript with them to the Conference and hand the original plus two copies to the editorial representative or the registration desk. Opportunity will be afforded to authors to amend their papers, where necessary, in the light of discussion at the Conference. All papers will be examined by referees and are expected to comply with the standards expected for a paper published by the Journal in a regular issue. Papers will be typeset, and manuscripts should be prepared according to the instructions available at http://www.elsevier.nl/locate/molstruc (submission of a diskette containing the electronic version of the manuscript, together with the paper copies, is strongly encouraged).

Social Events

All registered XXVII EUCMOS Participants as well as the accompanying persons are eligible to take part in the conference dinner. It will be organized in the founded in the XIII century picturesque Salt Mine Wieliczka, today one of the most popular touristic objects in Poland. It is worth noting that in 1976 Salt Mine Wieliczka was entered to the National Monuments Registry, in 1978 Mine was inscribed in UNESCO's 1st World List of Cultural and Natural Heritage, in 1994 it was acknowledged as the National History Monument by the president of Poland.

Additionally, a trip to the mountains with barbecue, also included in the conference fee, will take place. All participants are kindly asked to have the proper clothing for such a trip.

Travel and Other Information

1. Visas

Participants from most European and many non-European countries do not need Polish visas. Please contact the Polish Embassy or Consulate to verify whether you need a visa. If you do, a personal invitation letter may be necessary. The Organizing Committee upon request will provide it.

2. How to get to Kraków?

Kraków can be reached by plane, train or bus. Kraków airport has connections to some places in Europe as well as in the USA. In some cases it is convenient to come to Warsaw and take an express train to Kraków. There are express trains between Warsaw and Kraków approximately every 2 hours. It takes 2 hours 30 minutes to go from Warsaw to Kraków by such train. The are also international bus lines and trains to Kraków from many European towns.

3. How to get to the conference site in Kraków?

AGH-University of Science and Technology is located in Aleja Mickiewicza 30. It can be reached easily from the Kraków railway station (buses N° 208, 501) and from the Kraków airport (bus N° 208).

Please note that while using public transport special tickets should be validated by one of the machines placed inside the vehicle. Public transport tickets (the same for buses and trams) can be purchased at most of the newspapers stands as well as from the bus or tram driver (at some additional cost). There are several types of tickets:

- 2.40 zl fare for a single trip
- 3.00 zl fare for a 60 minute commuting

A taxi fare from the railway station to the conference place should be about 15 - 20 zl and from the airport about 50 zl.

4. Currency

The official currency of Poland is zloty (PLN, zl). 1 zloty = 100 groszy (gr). Coins are: 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50 gr, and 1, 2, 5 zl. There are also 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 bank notes. The exchange rate is approximately 4 PLN for 1 USD and 4.7 PLN for 1 Euro.

Foreign currency can be exchanged in the banks and in many small exchange offices located in different places of the town. International credit cards (VISA, Mastercard, Eurocard) are accepted in some shops downtown and can be used for cash withdrawals at banks and some banking machines (Bankomat).

5. Insurance

The Organizing Committee cannot accept any liability for medical or other problems. Participants should make their own arrangements with respect to health and other insurance.

6. Telephones

Phone cards are available at Post offices and most newspaper stands throughout Kraków. A telephone unit (about 3 minutes of local call) costs 35 gr. Most telephone boxes can be used for local as well as long distance calls. A long distance dial number consists of: 00 - country code - area code - local number.

7. Climate and Clothing


